

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON COOPERATION

Between

Da-Yeh University (DYU)

No. 168, Xuefu Rd, Dacun Township, Changhua County, Taiwan, R.O.C

And

Thu Dau MotUniversity (TDMU)

No.6, Tran Van On Street, Phu Hoa Ward, Thu Dau Mot City, Binh Duong Province, Vietnam

PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and between the DaYeh University, hereafter "DYU", with a registered address at No. 168, Xuefu Rd, Dacun Township, Changhua County, Taiwan, R.O.C, and Thu Dau Mot University, hereafter (TDMU), with a registered address at No.6, Tran Van On Street, Phu Hoa Ward, Thu Dau Mot City, Binh Duong Province, Vietnam. DYU and TDMU are referred to collectively, as "Parties".

1. PURPOSE

The Parties recognize the benefits to be derived from increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction for the further promotion and understanding of joint research projects and seminars, joint degree programs, student and faculty exchanges, etc.(hereafter, collectively referred to as the "Field").

The purpose of this MOU is to define the areas forjoint research projects and seminars, joint degree programs, student and faculty exchanges, etc.in which the Parties desire to work together in the future for our mutual benefit to foster a collaborative framework between TDMU and DYU in the Field with a view to benefiting from each other's

initiatives and working procedures and to support collaboration among the researchers associated with both Parties.

2. AREAS OF COOPERATION

Subject to the availability of funds, resources and approval of the Presidentsof both DYU and TDMU, both institutions agree to develop the following collaborative activities:

- 2.1. Conducting joint research and development project
- 2.2. Cooperation in individual projects
- 2.3.Organization of lectures, symposia, international meetings, conferences, and workshops
- 2.4. Exchange of faculties/researchers and students
- 2.5.Exchange of information, teaching materials, technological and scientific publications
- 2.6. Providing opportunities for professors and lecturers/researchers to give lectures
- 2.7. Joint degree programs
- 2.8. Assistance in matters of curricula
- 2.9. Search for opportunities to collaborate in the future

For any specific cooperative program, a mutual agreement will be reached and related documents will be signed.

3. IMPLEMENTATION

- 3.1. To assist cooperative relationships between our two institutions, each institution will, as far as it is reasonably able, provide access to research, library resources, computers, offices and similar support facilities for visiting personnel, as is appropriate and as will be agreed upon, for each cooperative program.
- 3.2. All programs or activities implemented under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon in writing, including the necessary budget for the program of activity as the need may arise.

- 3.3. Each of the participating institutions shall be fully responsible financially for the activities carried out under its direction or by its staff, except as otherwise agreed by the Parties.
- 3.4. Faculty departments, administration centers and other organizational units of each institution with personnel and students are encouraged to develop and maintain appropriate contacts within the framework of cooperative relationship between two institutions.
- 3.5. The Parties will designate one officer each who will develop and coordinate specific programs or activities between them.

4. DURATION AND RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective immediately after signature by the Presidents of both Da-Yeh University(DYU) and Thu Dau Mot University(TDMU) representatives for a period of 5 years and is subject to revision of modification by mutual agreement.

5. APPROVAL

This Memorandum of Understandingis officially written in English, and is mutually agreed upon by the President of the Da-Yeh University, and the President of Thu Dau Mot University, hereby affix signatures.
